# From one sketch to one finished digital product

The tool assists. Lily remains the creator.

## IMAGINE

Draw a friendly space-cat and decide what it wants.

2

## BUILD

Choose scenes, actions, sounds and story moments.

3

## TEST

Play it with Dad. Notice what is confusing or slow.

4

## IMPROVE

Change the instructions, pacing and final scene.

5

## FINISH

Save a playable story and private family share link.

## JOURNEY B | PHYSICAL / MAKER

1. SKETCH

2. CHOOSE MATERIALS

3. CUT SAFELY

4. SAND, PAINT & ASSEMBLE

5. FINISH

# From a family idea to something real

Safe tools, careful finishing and family pride are all part of the lesson.

## SKETCH IT

Choose the name, shape, tree and cultural pattern.

2

## CHOOSE MATERIALS

Compare wood, colors, size and layered depth.

3

## CUT SAFELY

Use supervised equipment behind its protective enclosure.

4

## FINISH WELL

Sand, paint, assemble and check every edge.

5

## PRESENT IT

Photograph it and explain what the design means.

Send a parent-approved private link.

# From original art to a tiny business lesson

Kai creates the product idea. His mother controls the business functions.

## 1 CREATE

Finish one strong ocean illustration.

## 2 ADAPT

Test it on stickers, a shirt, cards and a bottle decal.

## 3 CURATE

Choose only the products that look truly finished.

## 4 PRESENT

Arrange a small display and practice the explanation.

## 5 LEARN

Collect parent-reviewed feedback and improve.

**PARENT CONTROLS: STORE • MESSAGES • PAYMENTS • FULFILLMENT**

Selling is optional. Learning and finishing already count.
